

June 6, 2013	MJOC receives submission of individual budgets on \$9.4 million and \$13.1 million, with the latter being based on an additional \$12.9 in street bonds.
June 20, 2013	Measure J Commission unanimously approves a \$9.4 million budget recommendation for City Council 2013-014 Budget.
July 3, 2013	City Council approves 4 items from MJOC recommendations – Architecture & Design Museum, i-Hub accelerator campus improvements, Welwood Library improvements, and additional funding for Crosswalks
September 4, 2013	City Council reviews remaining recommendations from MJOC and City Staff recommendation of delaying action on \$3.2 million of those recommendations. In addition, City Staff submits recommendation of \$3.9 million in requests representing previous and new requests. City Council refers to Analysis Committee for further analysis the \$3,002,250 in delayed projects and \$3,932,000 in City Staff submissions. It is announced that there will be an additional \$3.78 million in funds to appropriate for Budget year 2013-2014 as a result of higher tax receipts and lower cost of funded projects.
September 19, 2013	MJOC resubmits to City Council \$4,835,430 in projects which MJOC and City Staff have agreed upon
October 2, 2013	City Council approves MJOC recommendations, with minor accounting adjustments, as submitted. Remaining funds to be allocated are \$3,002,250, in delayed projects and new funds of \$3,758,999, for a total of approximately \$3.76 million.
October 14, 2013	Treasurer of the City of Palm Springs, Jeff Kiehl, determines the updated amount for allocation is \$7,043,359, which represents new funds of \$4,041,109.
