IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

A tax return must be filed monthly, **even if no tax is due**. Returns are due on or before the last business day of each calendar month. If the due day falls on Friday, Saturday, Sunday, or a holiday, the due day shall be the last regular business day on which City Hall is open to the public prior to that due date. Late returns are subject to penalties and interest. A penalty of 25% of the amount of the tax due, plus interest of 1% per month, will apply to all delinquent returns. An additional penalty equal to 25% of the amount of the tax will apply if the tax remains unpaid for a period exceeding one calendar month beyond the due date, plus interest on the unpaid tax and interest on the unpaid penalties. For late returns where no tax is due, an assessment will be applied which shall be at the discretion of the Tax Administrator.

If mailing your returns, please allow a sufficient amount of days for the postal service to process and deliver your return. We recommend that you allow a minimum of 5 working days. Further note, local Palm Springs mail is routed through San Bernardino, CA.
