RE: Resignation from VillageFest Board

It is with some regret that I submit my resignation from the VillageFest Board. As stated in my application, I believed that my 20 years of related experience could enhance the work of the Board.

- *Background* in art, civic, and educational event planning, including selecting many types of vendors, speakers, entertainers, and food vendors.
- Experience as a gallery owner organizing shows and demonstrations for the more than eighty artists and artisans I selected and represented, and as a vendor myself, selling my books at arts and authors events.
- Understanding that when things are successful, they are to be built on, not necessarily changed. Consistency and dependability is important not only to the vendor, but attendee.
- Research skills necessary to find examples of others who are already
 using some of the ideas the board is considering implementing such as
 broadening the vendor categories, changing the layout, having food
 courts, etc.

• *Marketing skills* (traditional and non-traditional) to promote businesses, artists, non-profits, and tourism.

However, this evening, I was appointed to the finance sub-committe and not the marketing/vendor selection criteria committee - the area I am experienced in and passioned about. Since being a member of the VillageFest Board is a voluntary appointment, I no longer choose to be on the Board. I have little or no interest in working on the financial sub-committee and feel I would have little to contribute.

I believe this appointment was made in spite by the Board Chair with the pre-knowledge and encouragement of the Director and at least one other Board Member - in hopes that I would resign. If not, then regretfully he (or they) did not understand the negative impact that decision would make on me - considering my background, interests, the extensive research I had already done related to craft selection criteria and the reasons for my applying to be on this particular Board in the first place.

In any case, I wish the VillageFest Board well, and the City Council much success in finding the - *now two* - appointments to fill. I hope those selected will be less stubborn and/or outspoken and will "fit in" better than I.
