APPROVE THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING SITE PLAN FOR THE

SCULPTURE "RED ECHO" ON PRIVATE PROPERTY AT THE SPRINGS SHOPPING CENTER LOCATED AT THE NORTHEAST

CORNER OF GENE AUTRY TRAIL AND RAMON ROAD.

SUMMARY

This action is to approve the landscaping and lighting site plan for the sculpture "Red Echo" on private property at the Springs Shopping Center located at the northeast corner of Gene Autry Trail and Ramon Road.

RECOMMENDATION:

- Approve site plan for the sculpture "Red Echo" at the Springs Shopping Center; and
- 2) Authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documents.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

On June 4, 2008, the City Council approved the purchase of the sculpture "Red Echo" by Konstantin Dimopoulos for \$44,790 plus shipping and installation costs. The Public Arts Commission made the recommendation to install the sculpture in the median located at the intersection of South Palm Canyon Drive and Indian Canyon Drive. However, the City Council deferred selecting a site and did not designate placement of the sculpture at that time.

On February 17, 2010 City Council approved the conceptual placement of "Red Echo" at the Springs Shopping Center and directed staff to return with detailed placement, landscape and lighting plans for the sculpture. Staff procured the services of TKD Associates to develop a landscape and lighting plan for the site and provide a complete set of construction drawings.

The proposed landscaping and lighting elements are consistent with the requirements approved by the Planning Department on May 29, 2007 for this project. Upon completion of the landscaping installation the property owner agrees to maintain the

access paths, landscaping and other improvements to the site. Ownership and maintenance of the artwork will remain with the City of Palm Springs.

The public art fee collected from the Springs Shopping Center project was \$83,773. The cost incurred by the City to acquire and install the sculpture will be approximately \$59,000. The public art fees collected from this project will be applied towards the acquisition and installation costs. The remaining balance of \$24,664 will stay in the public art fund.

In accordance with the Public Arts Ordinance No. 1479 Chapter 3.37 the site meets the criteria under Section 3.37080 (a) Art Site Acceptability.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no impact to the General Fund. The cost of installation and maintenance shall be made from the Public Arts Account #150-30-4408-50015.


