Version 2:

LAS PALOMAS ("Cary Grant Estate")

Completed 1930 / Restored 2009

Built by local pioneer Dr. J. J. Kocher in Spanish Andalusian farmhouse style, including thick stucco walls and wooden windows and shutters. Residence of legendary actor Cary Grant from 1954-72.
