Re: Expiration of Current Trustee Serving on Board

Dear Mr. Thompson:

I am writing to inform you that Trustee Lock's term, on the Board of Trustee's for the Coachella Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District, will be expiring on January 1, 2011.

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code sections 2022(a) and (b), as the case may be, each person appointed by the County Board of Supervisors to be a member of the Board must be a voter in the County and a resident of that portion of the County that is within the District and each person appointed by a city council to be a member of the Board must be a voter in that city and a resident of that portion of the city that is within the District.

Also, Health and Safety Code section 2022(d) provides that persons appointed to the Board should have "experience, training, and education in fields that will assist them in the governance" of the District.

The City of Palm Springs must appoint a new trustee or reappoint Ms. Lock. Once the City has made a decision, regarding the new appointment or re-appointment, please provide the District with a letter stating the city's decision and the term the person will be serving on the Board.
