ACTION: Direct each Councilmember to submit to the City Clerk, by Wednesday, April 25, 2012, the names of eleven (11) finalists for further City Council review and action. **Motion Mayor Pro Tem Foat, seconded by Councilmember Mills and unanimously carried (5-0).**

2. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON THE GOVERNOR'S PROPOSAL TO ELIMINATE THE COLORADO RIVER REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD:

David Barakian, City Engineer, provided background information as outlined in the staff report dated April 19, 2012.

ACTION: Direct and authorize the Mayor to send a letter of opposition and outlining concerns to the Senate Budget and Fiscal Committee, regarding the Governor's proposal to eliminate the Colorado River Regional Water Quality Control Board. **Motion Mayor Pro Tem Foat, seconded by Councilmember Mills and unanimously carried.**
