SUBJECT: APPROVE AND AUTHORIZE SUBMITTAL OF CALIFORNIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY FORM 1130 DESIGNATING PERSONNEL TO ACT AS THE AGENT FOR THE CITY WHEN SEEKING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AFTER A DISASTER

### SUMMARY

It is recommended that City Council approve the California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) Form 130. Form 130 designates the City's Applicant Agents when seeking financial assistance after a Governor or Presidential disaster proclamation.

### RECOMMENDATION:

- 1) Approve the Form 130 Disaster Designees as the City Manager/Director of Emergency Services, Fire Chief, and Director of Finance and Treasury.
- 2) Direct the City Clerk to certify and transmit Form Cal EMA 130 to the Office of Emergency Services.

### STAFF ANALYSIS:

The California Emergency Management Agency (CalEMA) Form 130 authorize the positions listed to execute for and on behalf of the City of Palm Springs, for the purpose of obtaining certain Federal financial assistance under Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, P.L. 93-288, as amended, 42 U.S.C. 5121-5207, and Related Authorities as of June 2007 and/or State financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA).

The positions designated on the form are the City Manager/Director of Emergency Services, Fire Chief, and Director of Finance and Treasury.


California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA ) in Chapter 7.5 of California Code provides State financial assistance for recovery efforts to counties, cities and/or special districts

after a State disaster has been proclaimed. CDAA can be implemented as "stand alone" funding sources following a CalEMA Agency Secretary's Concurrence for a local emergency, or a Governor's Proclamation when there is no federal declaration.


Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, P.L. 93-288, as amended, 42 U.S.C. 5121-5207, and Related Authorities as of June 2007 provides Federal financial assistance for Individual and/or Public after a Federal Major Disaster or Emergency Declaration is proclaimed. Public Assistance can include response, recovery, and mitigation after a Emergency or Major Disaster Declaration. Individual Assistance can include recovery and/or mitigation after a Major Disaster Declaration is proclaimed.
