SUMMARY:

The City Council will consider adoption of Ordinance No. 1823.

RECOMMENDATION:

Waive the reading of the full text of the ordinance and adopt Ordinance No. 1823, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PALM SPRINGS, CALIFORNIA, REPEALING SUBSECTION 21 OF SECTION 8.04.510 OF THE PALM SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE, PERTAINING TO FIRE COMMAND CENTER REQUIREMENTS."

STAFF ANALYSIS:

On June 19, 2013, Ordinance No. 1823 was introduced for first reading, by the following vote:

ORDINANCE NO. 1823

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PALM SPRINGS, CALIFORNIA, REPEALING SUBSECTION 21 OF SECTION 8.04.510 OF THE PALM SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE, PERTAINING TO FIRE COMMAND CENTER REQUIREMENTS

City Attorney Summary

The current provisions of the Palm Springs Fire Code require the provision of a fire command center in buildings over 60 feet in height. Section 508.1 of the State Fire Code requires a fire command center in buildings over 75 feet in height. This Ordinance repeals the local fire code requirement for buildings over 60 feet in height; however, the minimum State Fire Code Section 508.1 requirement remains in effect and fire command centers in buildings over 75 feet in height will continue to be required.
