<u>SUMMARY</u>

The applicant of the Dakota desires to submit and process an amended and restated planned development and tentative map and requested the City Council to rescind Resolution 23404.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

The City Council approved the Dakota, a 43 unit residential planned development project on the west side of Belardo Road, south of Morongo Road, on July 3, 2013. On September 19, 2013, the applicant's attorney advised the City Attorney in writing that the applicant desired to make changes that would "result in a better project from both a neighborhood standpoint and from a marketing perspective."
