2016-17 SPONSORSHIP AND PROGRAM FUNDING GRANTS AND

CITY SPONSORED SPECIAL EVENTS.

SUMMARY

The City Council will consider the award and allocation of funds for the fiscal year 2016-17 sponsorship and program funding grants.

RECOMMENDATION:

- Award the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Sponsorship and/or Program Funding Grants in the total amount of \$767,500 in the General Fund and \$50,000 in the Public Arts Fund.
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to execute individual Sponsorship and Program Fund Grants, subject to approval by the City Attorney as to form.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

As part of the Fiscal Year 2016-17 budget process, the City Council Budget and Finance Subcommittee (Mayor Moon and Councilmember Kors) requested City Staff develop an application process for the submission of the Fiscal Year 2016-17 sponsorship and program grants.

The City received 63 applications requesting \$1,769,844 for sponsorship and/or program funding. Additionally, the City has funded, in whole or in part, four City produced special events (July 4th, Festival of Lights, Veteran's Day and the Mayor's Race) from sponsorship funds in the amount of \$125,000. The total amount of requested funds is \$1,894,844.

The complete list of applications received is attached for Council review and consideration. Staff analyzed the funding requests and made a good-faith effort to categorize each request as supporting or benefiting the following: tourism, fundraising,

resident benefits, and social services. In addition, the four TOT economic driver events are identified at the top of the Staff prepared list.

The Fiscal Year 2016-17 adopted budget, appropriated \$767,500 in the General Fund and \$50,000 in the Public Arts Fund. While the funds are appropriated in the Council approved and adopted budget, the City Council deferred the specific allocation of funding specific grants, and the funds are not allocated to any specific sponsorship or program. The City Council requested this special meeting to review and award specific sponsorships and program grants.

Staff recommends the City Council fund the three City sponsored special events as follows:

•	July 4 th Celebration	\$30,000
•	Festival of Lights	\$30,000
•	Veteran's Day Parade	\$15,000
		\$75,000

Funding the three City sponsored special events in the amount of \$75,000 leaves a balance of \$692,500 for funding sponsorship and grant requests in the General Fund, and \$50,000 in the Public Arts Fund. The list of Fiscal Year 2015-16 approved funding is attached for reference.

FISCAL IMPACT:

As part of the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget the City Council appropriated \$767,500 in the General Fund and \$50,000 in the Public Arts Fund for Sponsorship and/or Program Grants.

The recommended action provides for the City Council to approval grants and allocate the funds appropriated in the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget.
