SUMMARY

The City Council will consider the appointment of the City of La Quinta representative to the Palm Springs International Airport Commission.

RECOMMENDATION:

Appoint Kathleen Hughes, as the City of La Quinta representative, to the Palm Springs International Airport Commission for the term ending June 30, 2020.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

In November, 2007, the City Council amended the Palm Springs Municipal Code to provide that each representative City nominate, and the Palm Springs City Council appoint the representative member to the Palm Springs International Airport Commission.

As a newly appointed member to the Commission, you are required to receive **two hours** of training in general ethical principles and ethics laws every two years pursuant to AB 1234. A free on-line training course is available at http://localethics.fppc.ca.gov. Please complete the training, print the completion certificate, and submit it to the City Clerk Department by August 30, 2017. You are also required to receive **two hours** of training in Sexual Harassment Prevention and Education every two years per Assembly Bill No. 1661. Once the Personnel Department puts you in the system you will be notified with the website address, username and password. You will then complete the training and turn in your certificate by August 30, 2017.

As a new member of the Commission, you are also required to file a Statement of Economic Interest Form 700 (Form 700) pursuant to the City of La Quinta's Conflict of Interest Code. Your Form 700 will be for "Assuming Office". Please complete and sign the enclosed Form 700 and submit it to the City Clerk Department within 30 days. You may also complete and print an interactive version of Form 700 at the Fair Political Practices Commission website at www.fppc.ca.gov.
