OVERVIEW

Effective July 1, 2018 payment plans will be available to customers qualified as "very low-income", this allows qualified motorists to pay for open parking citations in a 3 month period. The payment plan is available to motorist whose financial situation is confirmed as a "very low-income" household, using guidelines established by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (www.huduser.gov). Motorist who apply for the Payment Plan will be asked to provide detailed income information that will allow the City to verify eligibility.

LOW-INCOME PAYMENT PLAN PARAMETERS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- Payment plans are only available to the registered owner or lessee of a vehicle.
- Vehicle must be registered in California.
- Application must be made within 60 days from the date of issuance, or 10 days from the Administrative Hearing date, whichever is greater.
- If approved for a payment plan:
 - There is a \$5 fee per citation to enroll in a payment plan.
 - o First payment is 40% of total amount due followed by two installments.
- All late fees and penalty assessments will be reinstated for customers that fall out of compliance.

LOW-INCOME PAYMENT PLAN QUALIFICATIONS

Low-income qualifications can be met in one of two ways: Registered owner or lessee:

1. Monthly income is 125 percent or less of the current United States Department of Health and Human Services poverty guidelines. **Proof of income from a payment stub/proof of earnings required.**

- 2. Receiving public benefits from at least one of the following programs: Proof of receipt of benefit required.
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - State Supplementary Payment (SSP)
 - California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids Act (CalWORKs)
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
 - o County Relief, General Relief (GR), or General Assistance (GA)
 - Cash Assistance Program for Aged, Blind, and Disabled Legal Immigrants
 - In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS)

To request a payment plan, print and complete the **Request for Parking Citation Installment Payment Plan**, available online (http://palmspringsca.gov/government/departments/finance-treasury/parking-citations) and return to the City of Palm Springs. The documentation will be reviewed, and if qualified, a confirmation of enrollment will be emailed or mailed (via regular USPS) to the motorist.

Customers that do not meet the very low income requirement may request a payment plan, however, no late fees or penalties are waived, a \$25 fee will be assessed, and it cannot exceed 4 installments. First payment is 40% of amount due followed by 3 installments.
