Contract Summaries

Contract Summaries are required to be submitted prior to occupancy for Vacation Rental Properties (excluding Homeshares)

Q: What are Contract Summaries?

A: Contract Summaries are a summary of the rental contract for stays 28 days or less.

This enables the Department of Special Program Compliance to monitor contract count limitations as defined in the municipal code 5.25.070(b)

Vacation Rental Certificates are valid for one year. You will need to complete and submit a renewal application each year at least 45 days before expiration. An annual renewal fee of \$944.00 is due at the time you submit your paperwork. Additionally, you will need to complete an annual safety inspection.

Please make sure all documents are complete as incomplete applications will be returned.
