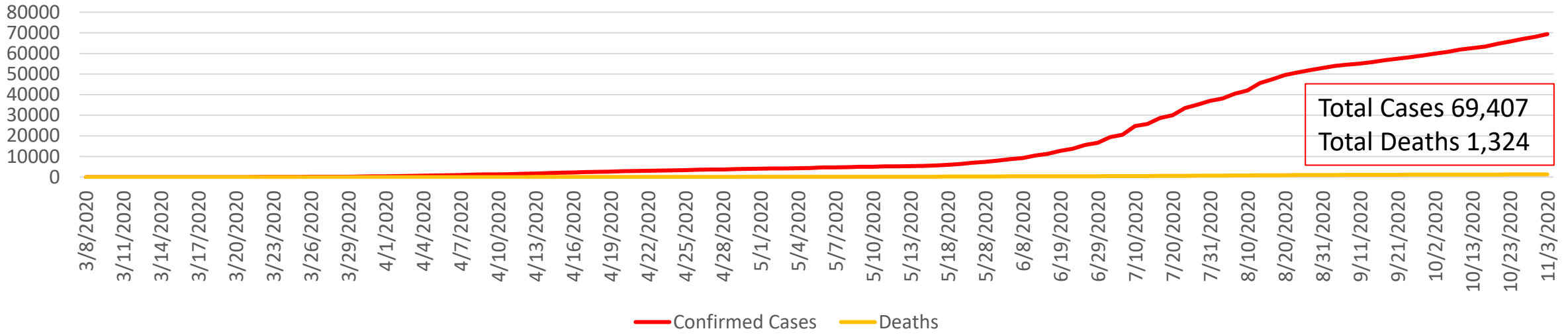

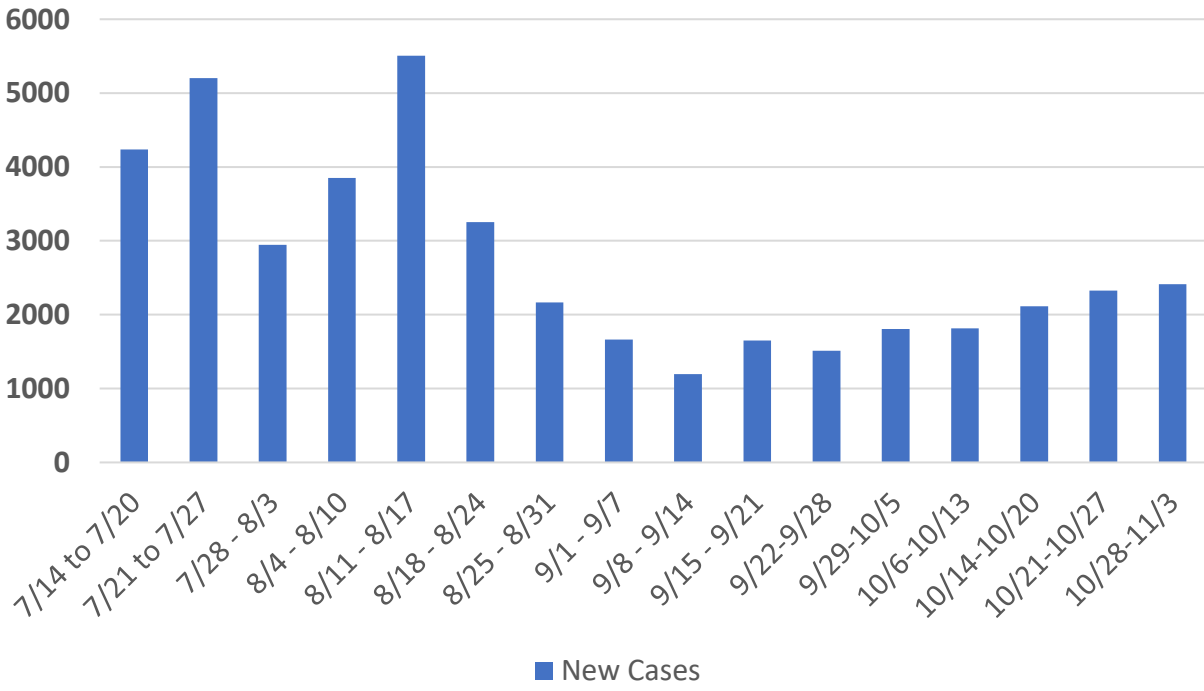

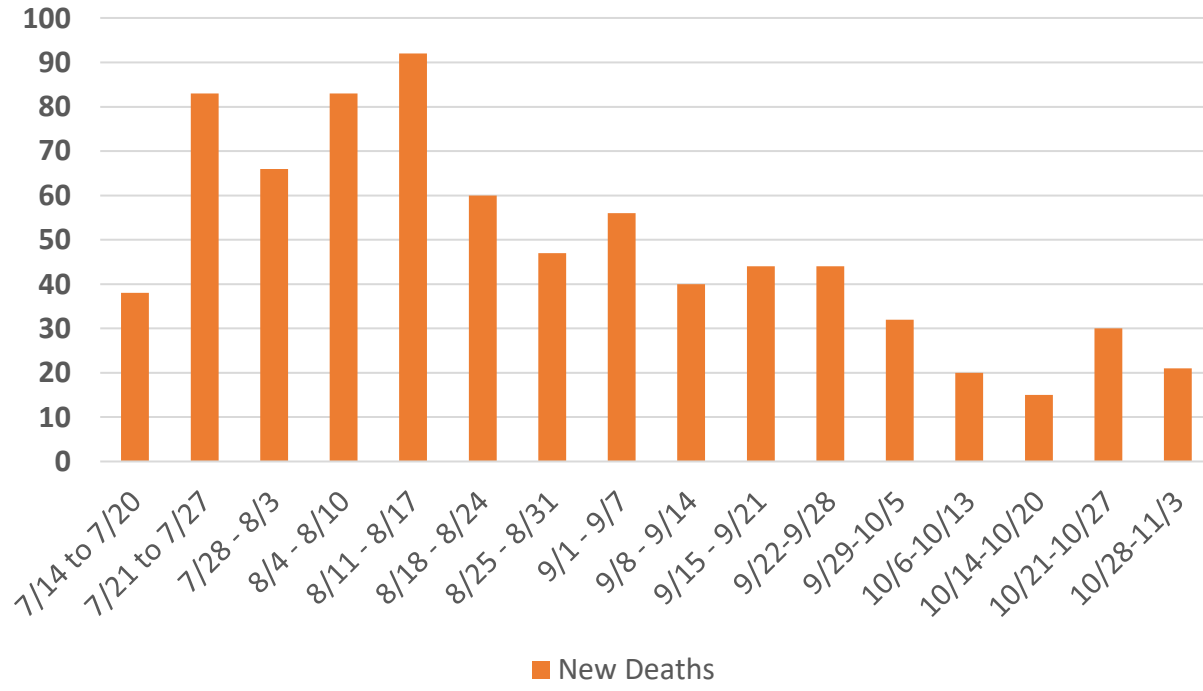

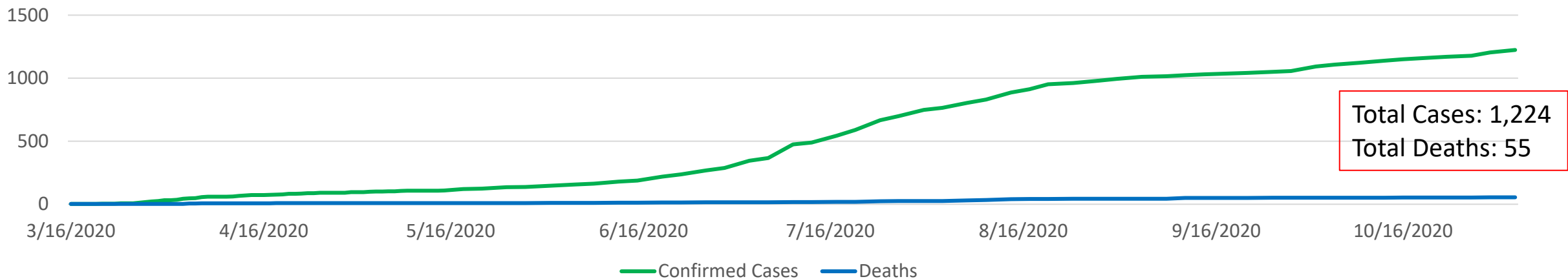
## Riverside County New COVID Cases



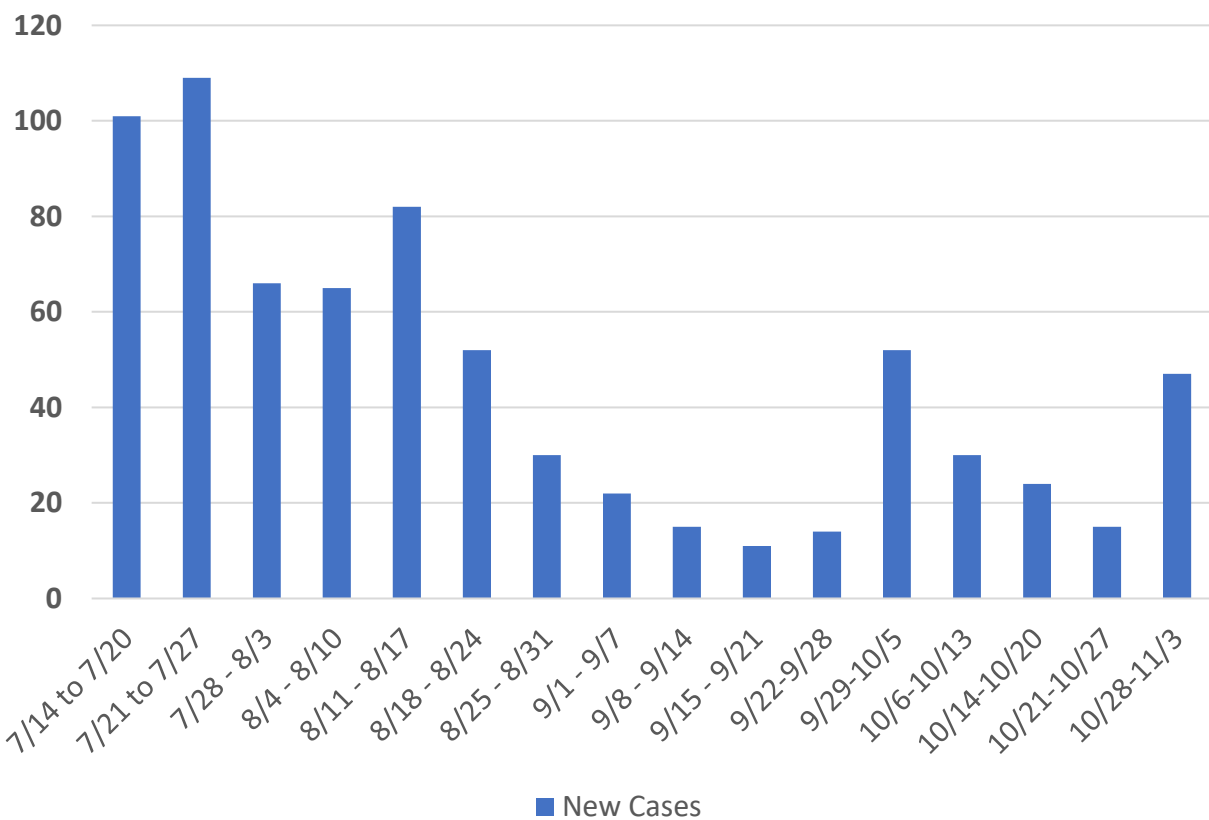
## Riverside County New COVID Deaths



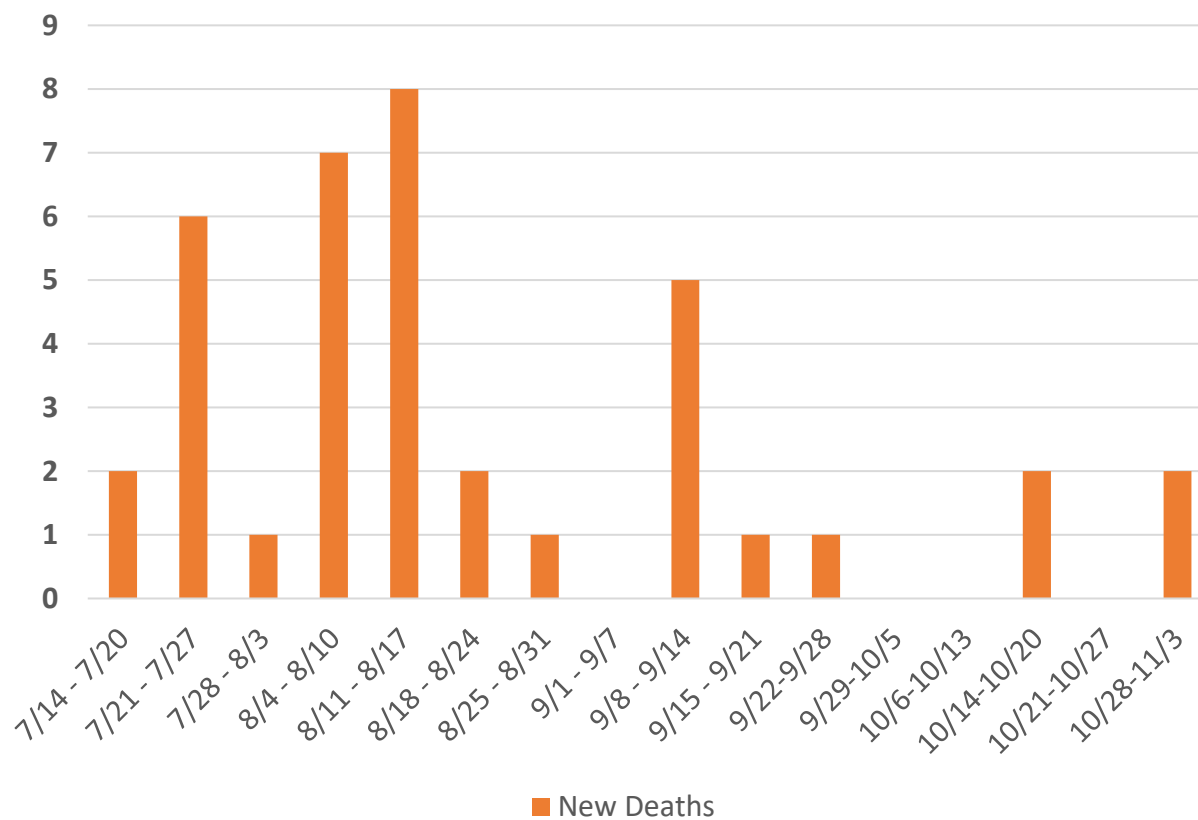

## Palm Springs New COVID Cases



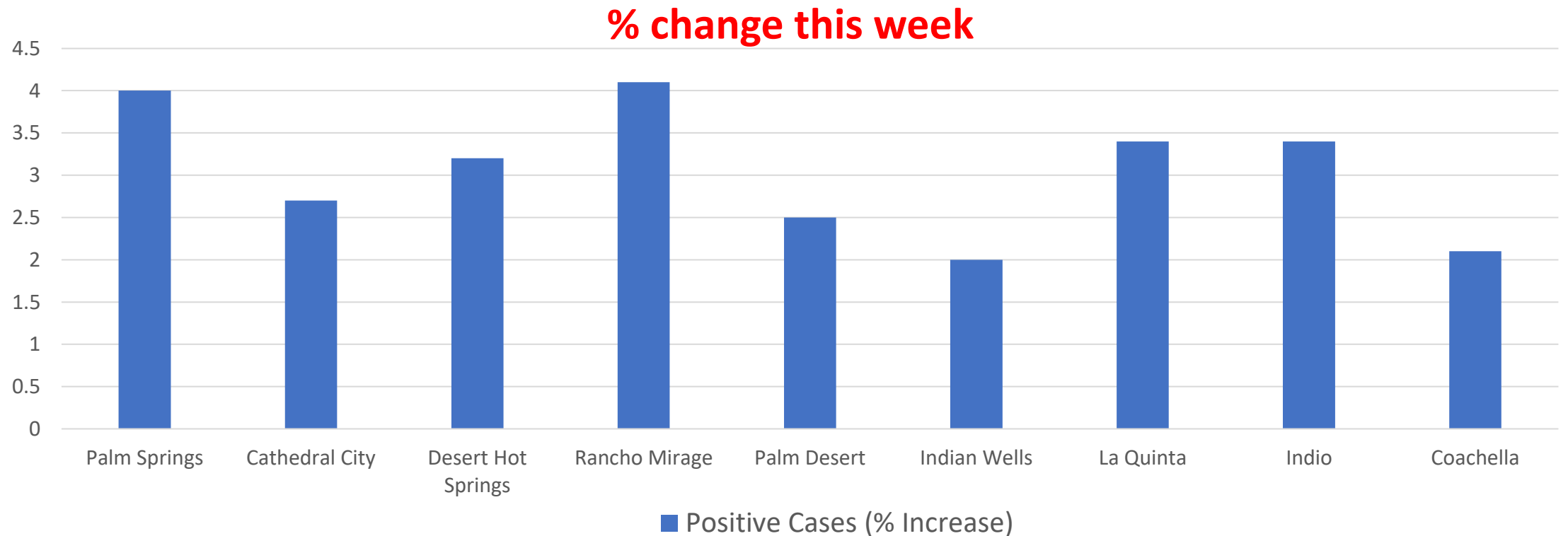

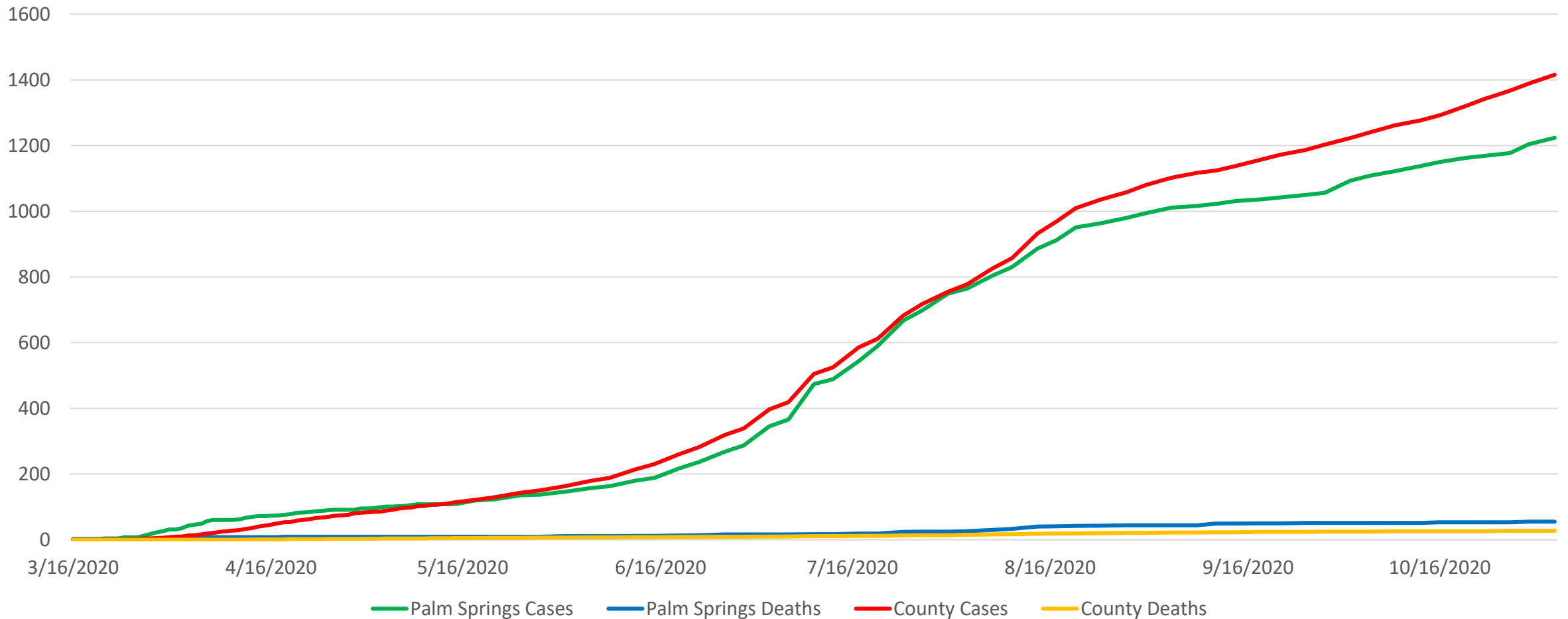

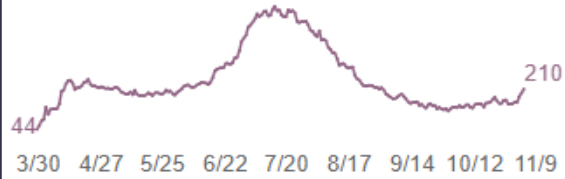

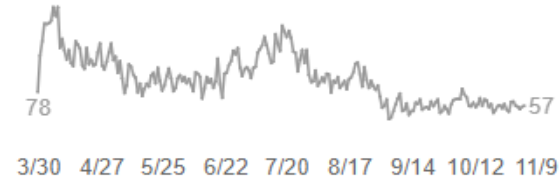

### Positive Patients by Facility/County

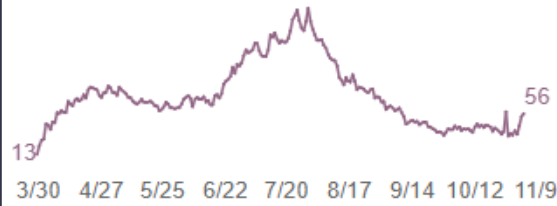

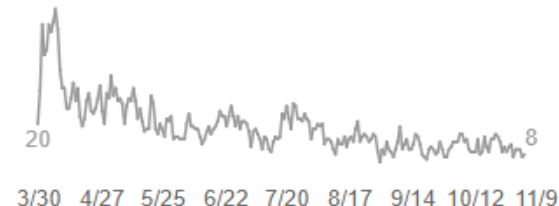
