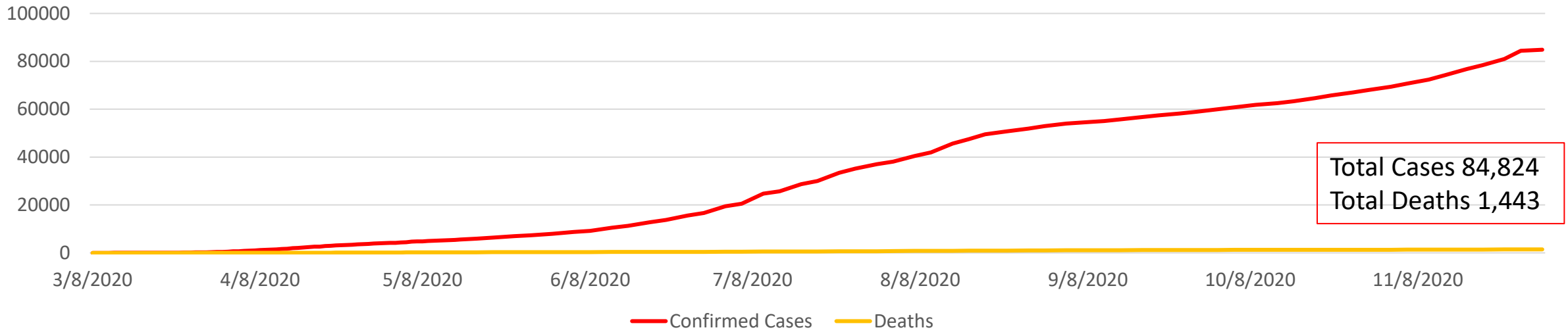

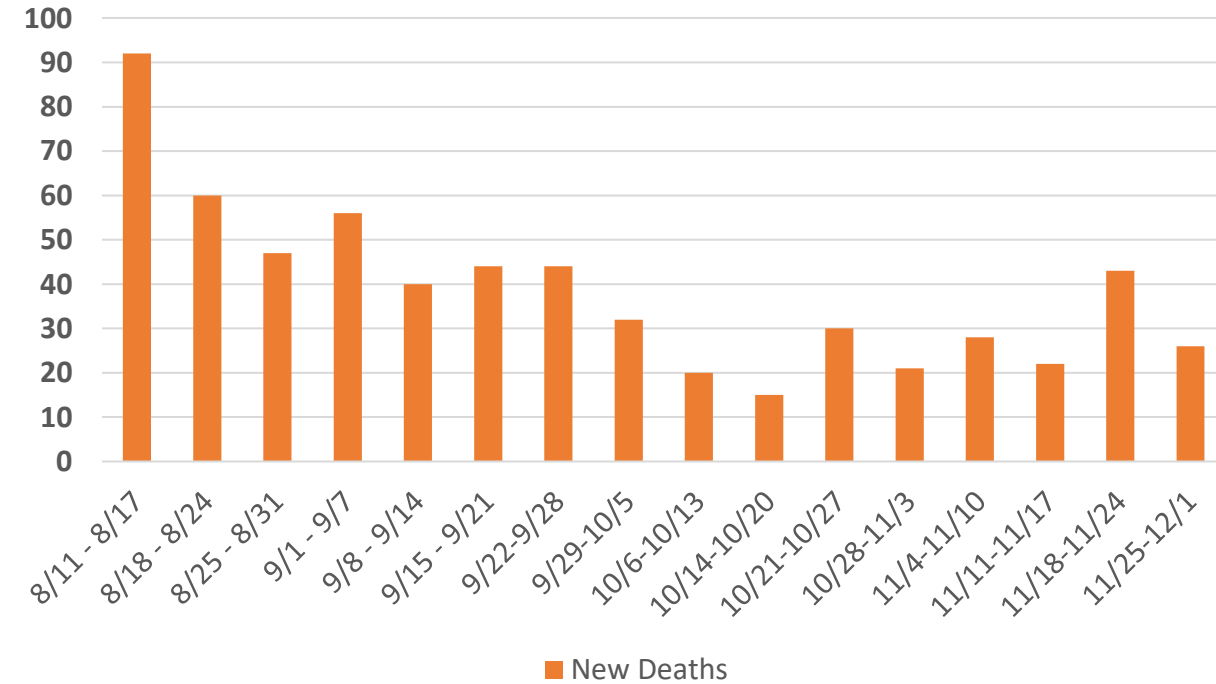

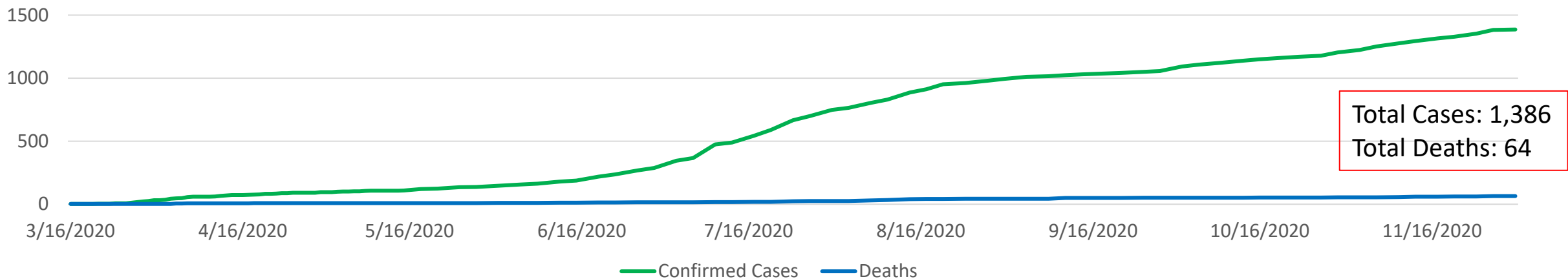
## Riverside County New COVID Cases



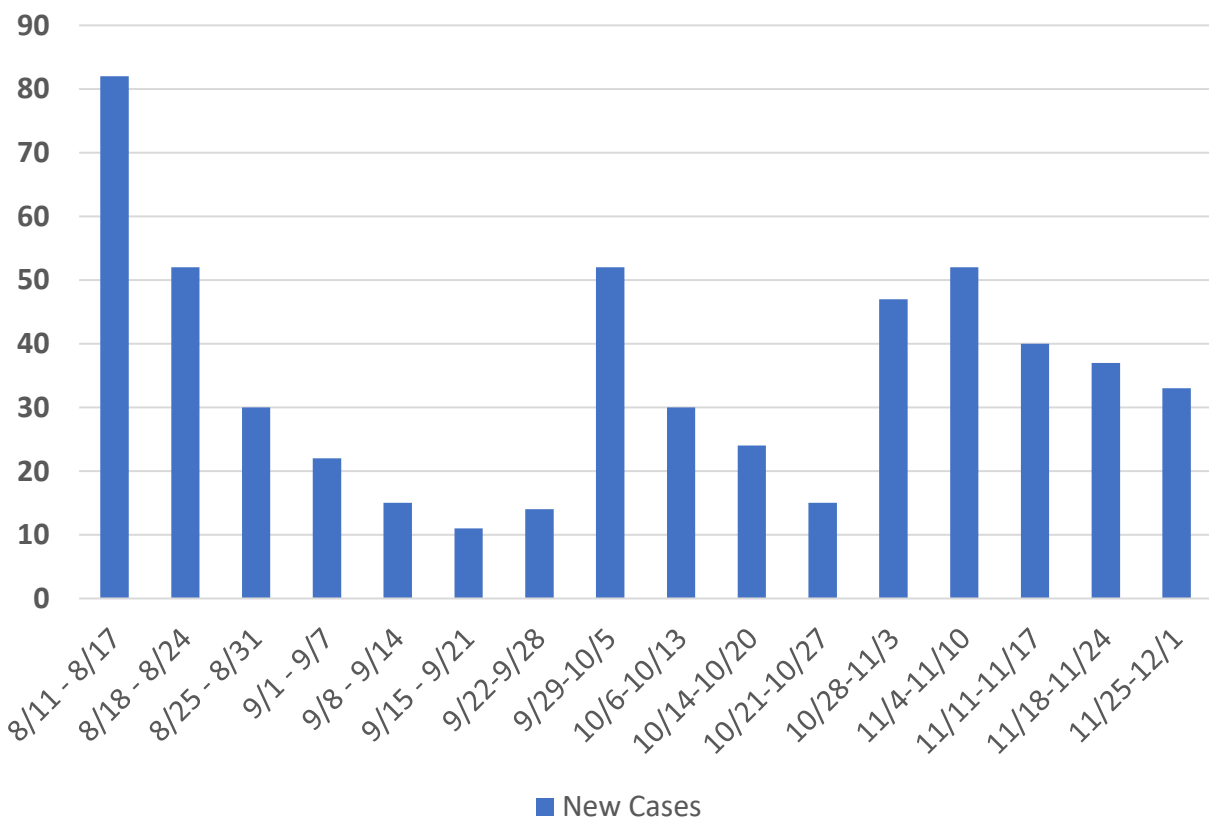
## Riverside County New COVID Deaths



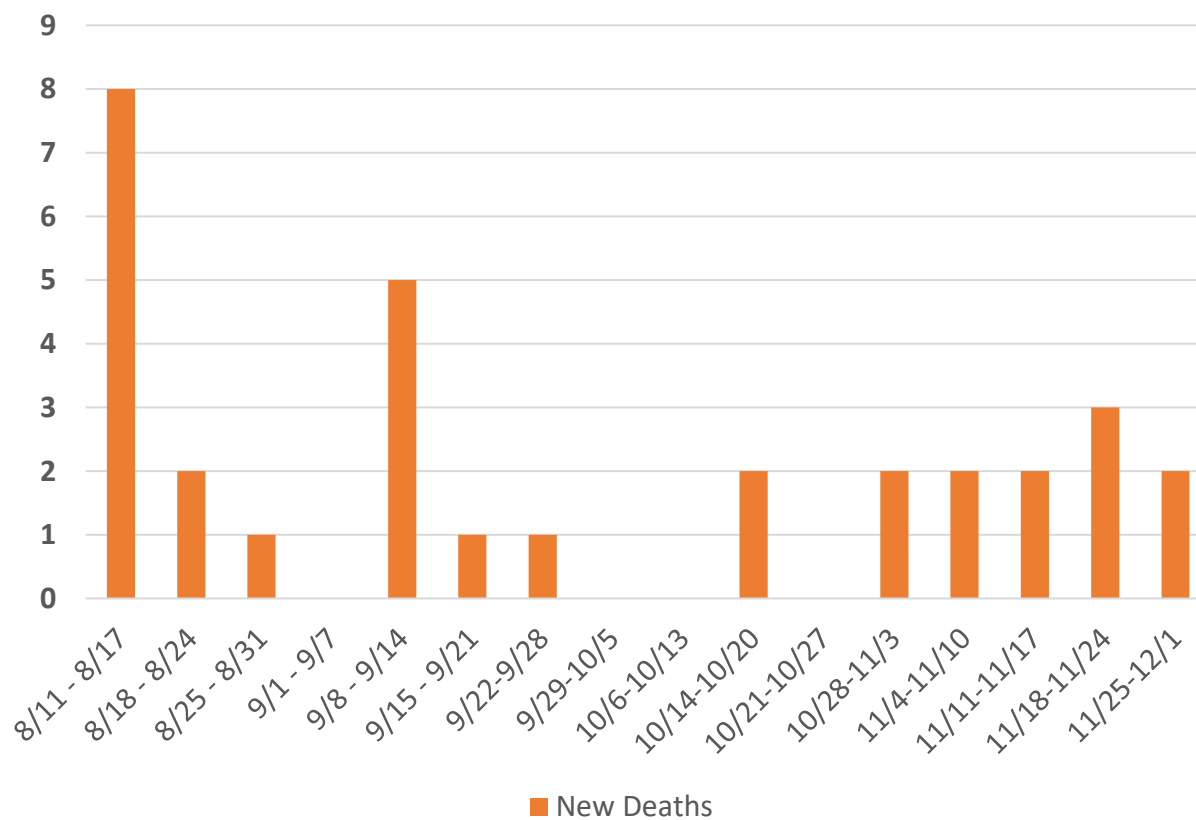

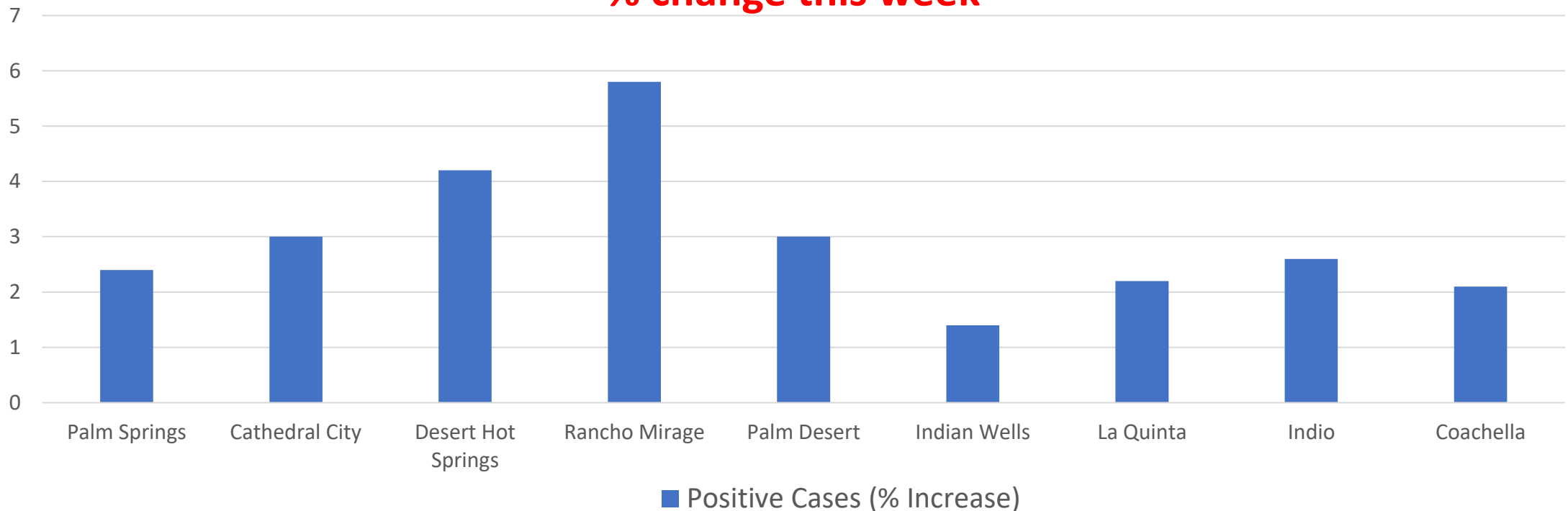

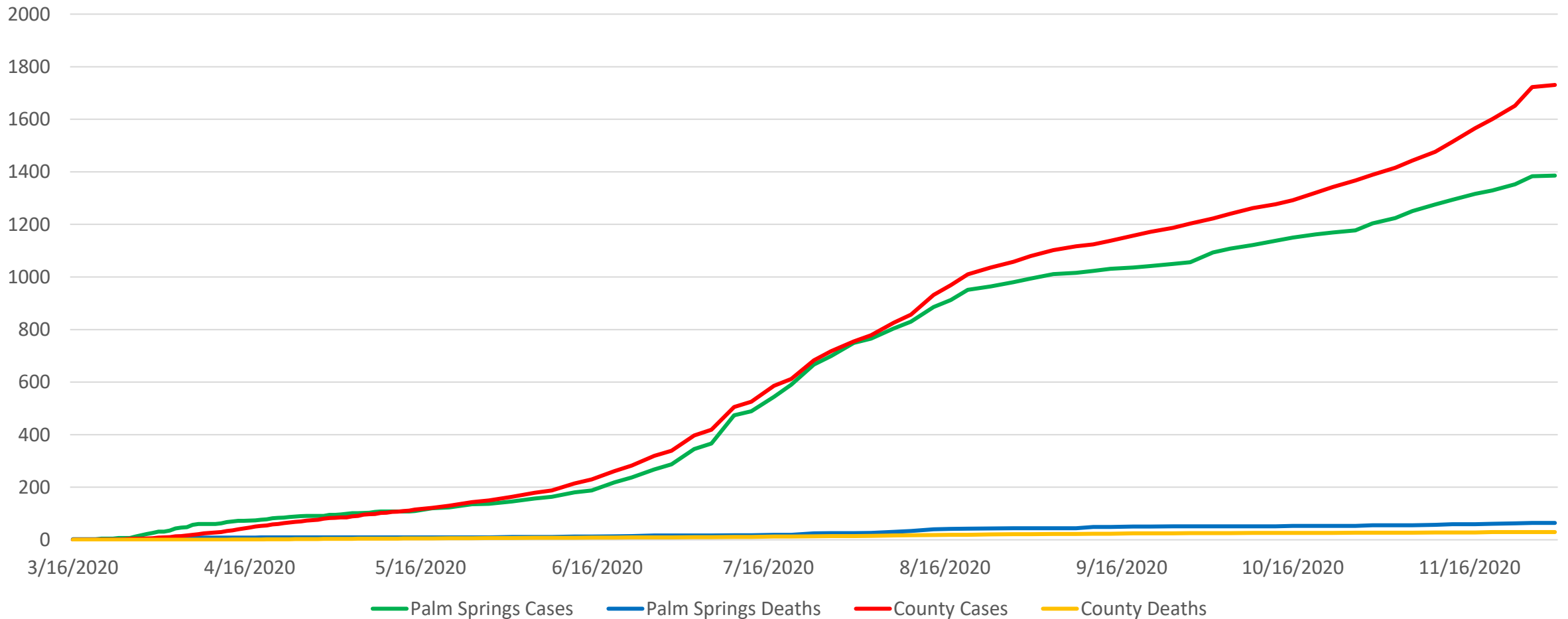

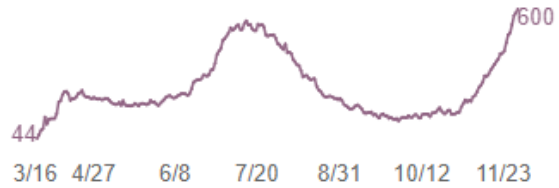

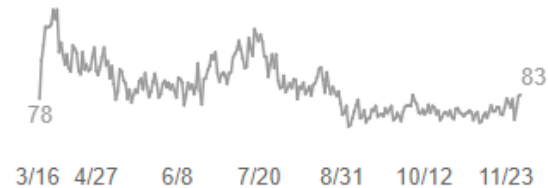

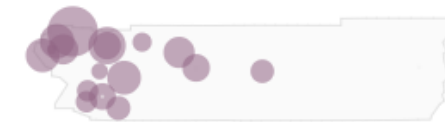

### Positive Patients by Facility/County

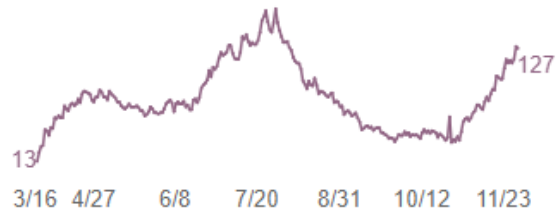

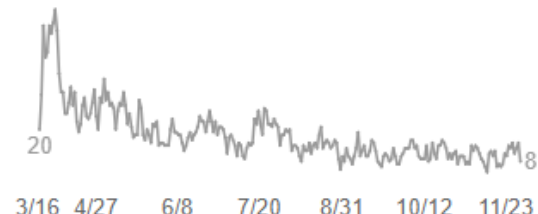

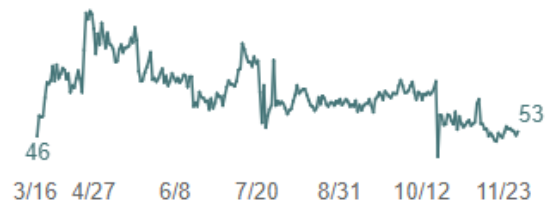
