## **Subcommittee Goal:**

Support the development of a pedestrian safety and safe routes to school plan

## **Summary:**

Manager Tallarico provided the following updates at the Ad hoc Subcommittee meeting on 4/12 regarding work done since the last meeting.

- KOA continues to collect data through the online survey and mapping tool.
- The City continues to send KOA information that we receive from residents to include in the analysis.
- KOA conducted 5 Virtual Walk Audits one for each District. Districts 2 and 5 had the most participants, but all sessions led to robust conversations about safety issues. The City will work with KOA to identify any remaining gaps in the data collection process to determine what more is needed.
- The next steps are to close out the data collection process and move on to the analytical phase of the work.
   This will involve reconvening the Community Advisory Committee and conducting Town Hall-style meetings to get feedback on priorities.
