Contract Summaries

Contract Summaries are required to be submitted prior to occupancy for Vacation Rental Properties (excluding Homeshares)

Q: What are Contract Summaries?

A: Contract Summaries are a summary of the rental contract for stays 28 days or less.

The contract submittal tool is located on our website. <u>Submit</u> Contract Summary

Failure to comply with this requirement constitutes a violation of the PSMC and is subject to an Administrative Citation Penalty of \$2,500 and a six-month suspension of the Vacation Rental Certificate, in accordance with PSMC section 5.25.090(d).

Meet and Greet Update

The virtual check-in process, permitted only during the COVID emergency, has ended.

The City of Palm Springs has resumed in-person meet and greets pursuant to PSMC <u>5.25.070(m)</u>. "The Owner or the Owner's agent or representative shall meet the Responsible Party in person at the Vacation Rental or the Owner's or Owner's agent's office prior to, or within twenty-four (24) hours of, the commencement of the occupancy and verbally explain and describe all rules and regulations applicable to the use of the property as a Vacation Rental and the responsibilities of the Responsible Party to the neighbors and the City as well as the Owner. The Owner shall secure the signature of the Responsible Party and all adult guests to a statement of rules and regulations ..."

Tourism Business Improvement District (TBID)

On July 1, 2021, Vacation Rental and Homeshare lodgings began paying the 1% TBID assessment on short term stays of 27 days or less.

Although the 1% TBID will be paid at the same time as your monthly TOT payments, TBID money is a separate item that will be directed to the CVB.
