- Airport Demonstration Garden To date, the grass has been removed and grading and compaction
  have been completed, irrigation has been installed and boulders have been installed. Marina Landscape
  is in the process of installing forms and concrete. Signage quotes have been obtained from three local
  vendors and a ribbon cutting ceremony will be planned once the construction and sign installations are
  completed. It is anticipated work will be completed by the end of February 2022 to ensure that plants
  have time to get established before the summer heat.
- **EV Charger Expansion progress** —Carbon Solutions Group (CSG) anticipates the EV chargers at the Museum Garage and City Hall will be operational in February 2022. The next location will be the Downtown Parking Garage on Baristo.
- Sustainability Scholarships City staff continues outreach to local businesses to apply for the

Sustainability Scholarship program which focuses on assisting food vendors with compliance of the Food Ware Ordinance, EV chargers and electric leaf blowers. Below is a table of recent scholarships requests and payments:

- Turf Conversion Projects On January 4, 2022, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted an emergency regulation that prohibits certain wasteful water use practices statewide. The following locations have been identified as public spaces which need to have the watering requirements adjusted. Please be aware there will be brown grass for a time after the watering stops while new xeriscape landscaping is selected and installed in the following medians:
  - o Kirk Douglas Way on the south side of the airport and around the airport parking areas

- o Palm Canyon Drive between Farrell and Cerritos drives
- o Ramon Road from Cerritos Drive to Sunrise Way
- o Sunrise Way from Ramon Road to Camino Parocela
- o A stretch of Ramon Road east of Farrell Drive to about a block west of El Cielo Road

Theses turf conversion projects will be led by the Maintenance Department by Director Shafer with support from the Office of Sustainability.

# Palm Springs City Hall South Parking Lot 3200 Tahquitz Canyon Way

- Enter the drop-off area along El Cielo Road.
- Please do not block entrance and exit while waiting.
- Collection will run throughout the morning or until trucks are full.
- Paper shredding is limited to three (3) normal size file boxes per vehicle. Size of box should be no larger than 9" X 13" X 17".
- All electronic equipment received at the event is dismantled and recycled.
- Any information stored on hard drives or cell phones is destroyed during the processing.
- Please do not bring any household hazardous waste materials such as light bulbs, tires, air conditioning units that may have refrigerants, and equipment that may have oil and gas.
- This event is open to all Palm Springs residents only.

- Stay in your vehicle
- Put materials to be shredded/recycled in your trunk or rear of your vehicle
