WHEREAS, Section Fourteen (14), Township Four (4) South,
Range Four (4) East, San Bernardino Base and Meridian
continues to be an eyesore to the community in that various
persons are indiscriminately dumping all manner of materials;
and

WHEREAS, the City has in the past cooperated with various
groups in an attempt to clean up the said Section,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does
respectfully request the Indian Tribal Council, Bureau of
Indian Affairs, the individual Indian allottees and the
Conservators and Guardians Association to aid the City in
a drive to clean up Section Fourteen (14).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City will assist as much
as possible in controlled burning and can assist in dis-
posing of old cars by checking out registration or engine
numbers to aid the above named persons and groups in dis-
posing of the automobiles, however, the City can not afford
to haul the automobile bodies away.
