City Manager - with recommendations:

1. Playhouse theatre license: Referred to flat fee to Palm Springs Playhouse Guild for use of Pavilion (Res. No. 3796, 6-17-53) and commented that in granting that fee matter of business license fee was overlooked; heretofore Mr. Rogers paid \$115.00 per year; inquired as to Council pleasure in matter.

Following discussion, Mayor announced consensus: The Guild should pay the fee; and should be so informed by City Manager or City Clerk.

2. Enforcement of State Housing Act regulations on Indian Land - Section 14: Referred to moratorium declared by Council in December 1951 (Resolutions 3307-08, Dec. 19, 1951 and prior); reviewed situation and requested Council expression regarding policy for further action.

Mr. Strebe offered a motion, seconded by Nathanson, that moratorium on enforcement of State Housing Act violations be terminated under notices to violators, effective six (6) months after date of such notices, that within said six (6) months from said date the house or trailer so occupied must be removed; or, in case the violation concerns occupancy of a house, that such house shall be so remodelled as to bring it into conformance with existing standards of State and City for such occupancy; said notices to be given without delay.

Following discussion the motion and second - as Res. No. 3808, was adopted by voice vote; no dissenting vote; Mayor Farrell absent.

- 3. Swimming Pools: Reported as matter of information census enumerators had counted 511 pools as of March 1, 1953.
- 4. Appropriations recommended for accounting adjustments 1952-53, as per itemized request (copies distributed among Council): On motion by Strebe, seconded by Hardy, Res. No. 3809, authorizing and directing procedure recommended, as follows:
