

4. North End Park:

- a) Shelter House Change Order No. 2 (Res. No. 3672, 9-2-53 and prior): Reported that as a matter of safety in making building more burglar-proof it has been deemed advisable to enclose a portion of wall and roof in storage room under a change order for an additional \$100., which he is recommending. On motion by Hardy, seconded by Sanborn, Res. No. 3898; authorizing and directing procedure recommended was adopted by record vote; no dissenting vote.
- b) Formal Naming of Park (Item 8-d, City Manager Report, 6-30-53 and prior): Later in meeting Mrs. Hardy reviewed circumstances involved in selection of name and reported that Park and Recreation Board (of which she is Secretary) has suggested name

offered a motion that park be so named and that suitable directional signs be placed along Palm Canyon Drive and Indian Avenue and that a sign be placed in DeMuth Park indicating that picnic facilities are available in Tamarisk Park. The motion was seconded by Mr. Nathanson and adopted as No. 3899 by voice vote; no dissenting vote.

- 5. State Housing Act Enforcement covering Abatement of Nuisances (Res. No. 3891, 9-18-53 and prior): Referred to procedure taken in meeting of September 18, 1953 regarding substandard buildings in Section 14 (Indian Land) and procedure then taken and recommended adoption of a resolution establishing a

to carry out procedure under State Housing Act; said Board to be composed of three (3) members: City's Chief Building Inspector, Building Inspector and the County Health Officer assigned to this area under contract with Riverside County; also appointment of a Deputy Clerk designated by City Clerk to serve as Clerk of said Board. On motion by Sanborn, seconded by McKinney, Res. No. 3900, authorizing and directing procedure recommended, was adopted by voice vote; no dissenting vote.

- 6. Off-Street Parking (Item 5, City Manager Report, September 15, 1953 and prior): Reported that Retail Merchants Association and Planning Commission are working on problem.
