AMENDMENT TO THE CPI TO BE USED FOR ANNUAL INCREASES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Palm Springs, California, will hold a public hearing at its meeting of May 25, 2023. The City Council meeting begins at 5:30 p.m., in the Council Chamber at City Hall, 3200 East Tahquitz Canyon Way, Palm Springs. Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361, this meeting may be conducted by teleconference. View the City Council meeting live at the City's website at www.palmspringsca.gov/pstv, YouTube, or Channel 17 (Spectrum).

The purpose of this public meeting is to solicit public comments and consider the following:

- a. The proposed amendment to the Consumer Price Index used for the annual escalation of its Comprehensive Fee Schedule in conformance with the percent change for January of the current year from January of the prior year, derived from the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for All items less food and energy in the Riverside-San Bernardino-Ontario, CA, all urban consumers, region.
- b. The proposed modifications to user fees and charges prior to the adoption of a Resolution revising and updating the City's Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Comprehensive Fee Schedule, and to include a CPI increase to certain fees as authorized by the City Council. Under state law, all fees charged by the City must be reasonably related to the actual cost of providing various public services.

The staff report and other supporting documents regarding the FY 23/24 Comprehensive Fee Schedule are available for public review online, at www.palmspringsca.gov/CFS. A copy of the FY 23/24 Comprehensive Fee Schedule will be available online for examination and comment in the Office of the City Clerk, City of Palm Springs, 3200 E. Tahquitz Canyon Way, Palm Springs, California, 92262.

You may be added to the queue at any time prior to the end of the public comment period for the subject hearing. Any correspondence received during or after the meeting will be distributed to the City Council as soon as practicable and retained for the official record.
