Valet Parking Application / Permit - Parking Regulations

The valet operator shall assure that all drivers employed by this operation must have in their possession a valid, current driver's license for the type of vehicle that they are operating.

Vehicles are permitted to occupy the valet loading zone for no more than five (5) minutes. The operator shall provide sufficient staff to ensure that vehicles are moved from the valet loading zone promptly and moved to the storage location.

Vehicles shall be parked only in the assigned storage facility. Vehicles shall not be parked on any street, alley or other public right-of-way unless specifically approved in the Temporary Valet Parking Application/Permit.

Vehicles shall be moved to and from the storage facility only via the approved route as noted in the permit application. Valet personnel transporting vehicles between the valet zone and the storage facility shall comply with all applicable traffic laws, ordinances and regulations and shall obey all traffic controls. Shortcuts and U-turns are prohibited.

Valet personnel traveling on foot between the valet zone and the storage facility shall comply with all applicable traffic laws, ordinances and regulations and shall obey all traffic controls. Jaywalking and crossing against traffic signals is prohibited.

The valet operator may utilize one pedestal sign, with size not to exceed 24 inches wide and 36 inches high per valet zone. Pedestal signs may be placed only on the sidewalk or in the parkway. Signs, cones and other items shall not be placed in the roadway.

Kiosks, umbrellas, desks, key lockers and similar items are not permitted on the sidewalk, parkway or other parts of the public right-of-way. All such items shall be placed only on private property.

The valet operator shall maintain a copy of these regulations and the approved Temporary Valet Parking Application / Permit at the valet location. It shall be shown to any customer or City Official upon request.

Violations of these regulations, or any other statutes, laws or ordinances may result in the termination of the Temporary Valet Parking Application / Permit and/or the Special Event Valet Parking Permit.

We agree to comply with these regulations and all other applicable statutes, laws and ordinances as well as the conditions of the Temporary Valet Parking Application / Permit.
