Subject: 2023-2024 HSPB Work Plan

BACKGROUND

The Historic Sites Preservation Board develop a work plan to focus and set priorities for the Board's efforts and activities through the coming fiscal year. The work program typically consists of two parts:

1.) Community Education / Outreach

2.) Sites to consider for recommendation to City Council for historic designation

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR EDUCATION & OUTREACH FOR FY 23 / 24

- 1. Participation in Modernism Week Modernism Show at the Convention Center (if scheduled). (October 2023 and February 2024).
- 2. Produce the annual "Preservation Matters" symposium.
- 3. Update PDF's of informational handouts on the "Historic Resources" portion of the City website.
 - a. Develop maintenance related resources and handouts for homeowners
- 4. Individual board member participation in continuing education through OHP, CPF, webinars, on-line workshops, etc.
- 5. Invite local historic preservation related experts for "15-minute guest speaker" series for quarterly presentations at HSPB meetings.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR OTHER INITIATIVES & OPPORTUNITIES FOR FY 23/24:

- 1. Apply for a grant from the Certified Local Government program through the State Office of Historic Preservation (OHP).
- 2. Online database of locally designated historic resources on GIS and other possible platforms for sharing historic information.
- 3. Historic Preservation Ordinance clean-up and potential updates.
