Eligibility Checklist for Building SIMPLE – HVAC Replacement

This checklist is provided to determine if your application is eligible for Building SIMPLE permit processing. If any item is checked NO, revise design, otherwise complete a standard application and review process.

Owner/builders cannot apply for Building SIMPLE permits at this time.

INSPECTIONS

The installing company must coordinate inspections through Palm Springs Online.

A clear, legible copy of the manufacturer's installation instructions and/or plans must be on site for inspection.

For quality control purposes, Inspectors may require that the installation technician be present during the inspection to open disconnects / equipment and answer questions about the installation.

If any inspection is failed, the installing technician must be present during re-inspection.

If the Inspector cannot perform a full code compliance inspection due to the complexity of the installation or the use of non-standard or unlisted components, the SIMPLE permit will be voided, and a standard plan review will be required.
